On behalf of Kiswire Ltd. and Kiswire America Inc. (collectively “Kiswire”), we hereby notify the U.S. International Trade Commission of an error on page 4 of our post-conference brief that was filed on April 21, 2017 in the above-referenced proceeding.

Page 4 of the brief incorrectly states that, “{a} low magnesium content of 0.3 to 0.6 percent is necessary to establish sufficient ductility to produce the thin strands required for tire cord and bead wire.”

This statement should instead read that, “{a} low **manganese** content of **0.25** to 0.6 percent is necessary...”


